<p>Course outcomes: By the end of the course, you will be able to:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • Handle a conversation with growing confidence and using an expanded vocabulary • Produce written work about past experiences or describing movies, books or similar • Interact more naturally using idiomatic expressions • Use an increasing variety of regular and irregular tenses and grammar structures • Ask for & provide a variety of more detailed information when on holiday in Italy • Talk about some elements of the Italian culture
