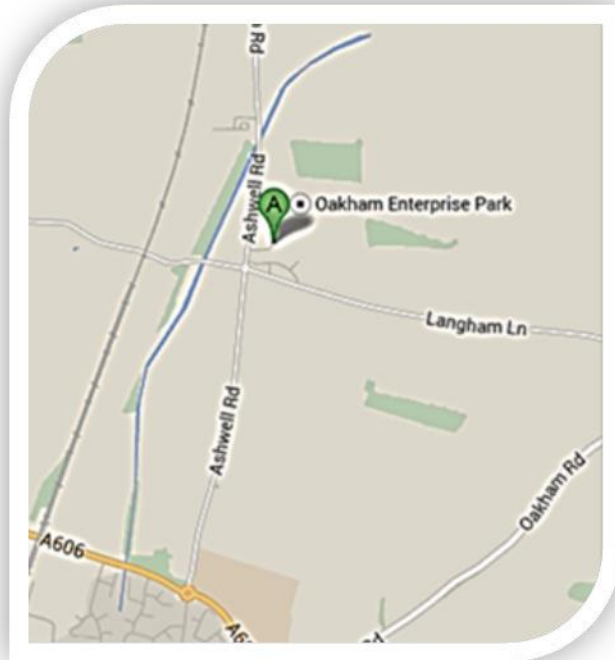
Course Information
