Fees and Funding:

Most of our courses are subsidised using funding from the Department of Work and Pensions. Some courses are subsidised but still have a fee to pay, and others are free for learners who meet the funding criteria. Where a fee is paid, our standard rate is £7.50 per hour, but the cost of some courses (including unfunded courses) may be higher depending on the subject.

Financial Support

Tailored Learning concessions

You could receive a 50% discount on Tailored Learning courses if you are in receipt of, or are the unwaged dependent of someone who is in receipt of, certain state benefits. You could also be eligible for concessions if your gross annual household income is less than £26,800 per year.

Discretionary Learner Support Fund

If you're unemployed or on a low income and are enrolled onto one of our qualifications, we may be able to help you with your transport, exam, awarding body registration or childcare costs through our Discretionary Learner Support Fund. If you are attending our non-qualification ESOL courses, we may also be able to help with your transport costs.
